NR1.08100.24000. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches who are 7 years & under 9 years.

NR1.08100.36800. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches who are 9 years & over.

Spayed bitches and neutered dogs are eligible to compete pursuant to Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 8, and effective

NR1.43650. Versatile Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches holding the NCA Versatile Newfoundland Title. **Must not be altered.** Winners of these classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition.

00900. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

SPECIAL ATTRACTION CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Spayed bitches & neutered dogs are eligible to compete in these classes.

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Get may be of either sex. Ownership does NOT need to be the same for each dog in the unit of three. The **STUD DOG IS THE ENTRY** in the stud dog class and must be shown in the ring with his get. Get need not be identified at time of entry. The unit will be judged solely on the merits of the get and, while the merits of the stud dog are not considered for placements, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would be disqualified or excused under AKC Rules According to Dog Shows, AKC policy or the breed standard.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - Same as the Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

ADDITIONAL SPECIAL ATTRACTION CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Spayed bitches & neutered dogs are eligible to compete in these classes.

NR2.09300. Brace Class - Two Newfoundlands with at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The two dogs in the unit **MUST** be identified at the time of entry. The information for each dog entered in the Brace Class must be filled out on individual entry forms. Only one entry fee is charged per unit. If more than one Brace unit is entered by the same owner, the entry form for each dog must indicate Brace 1, Brace 2, etc.

NR2.31190. Breeders' Class - Each unit will consist of four Newfoundlands that share at least one breeder/co-breeder. Entries are submitted by the breeder and all dogs in the unit must be listed on the entry form, no substitutions allowed. Individual dogs may compete in only one Breeders Class unit, but a breeder can enter more than one unit if they wish. The unit can be the same or different sexes. Each individual dog must also be entered in a regular or non-regular conformation or companion dog class. The unit must represent at least two different combinations of parents. Champions of record can be shown in this class and dogs may be altered. Each dog shall have its own handler. The breeder must be present for the award but is not required to handle any entrant.

As the judge's decision in the Special Attraction Multiple Dog Entry Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won these classes

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
